2	New Hardship Fund	The WCO updated the Officer Team on planning for a new hardship fund, following additional government funding for students facing hardship during the COVID-19 national lockdown. The WCO noted plans for direct payments to students identified as 'estranged', with the remaining funding allocated to existing hardship processes. The Officer team discussed the apportioning of the additional hardship funding by the University. JT noted that much greater detail of data from the University would be needed for appropriate targeting of funding and communications to students. The PGO noted the need for detailed conversations with the University on appropriate criteria for eligibility for the fund and handling of 'marginal' cases. The PGO suggested the value of targeted funding for all students.	Noted
